

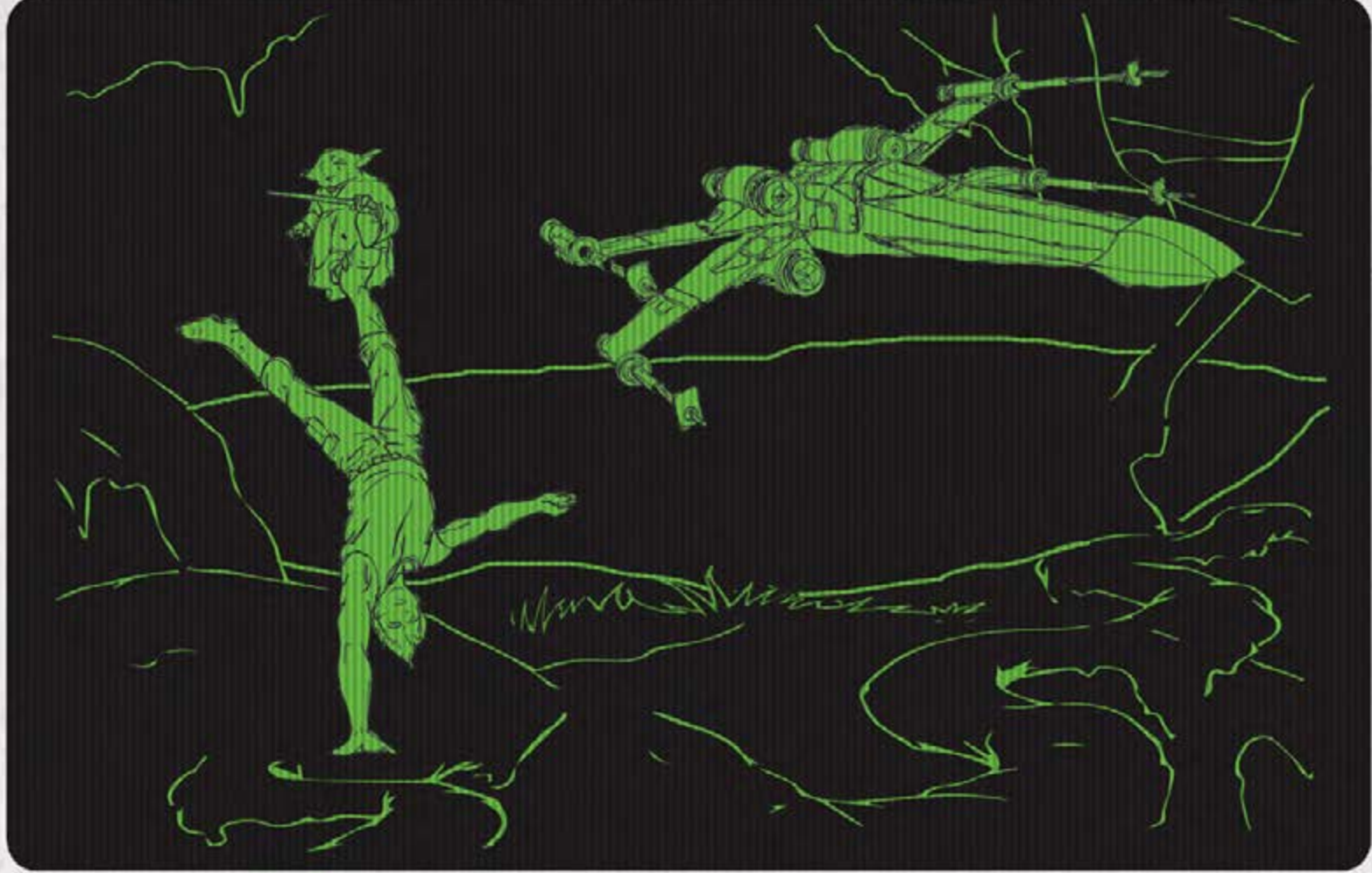

## Tactic #1: Levitation

On Hand Now		
Weapons	CKM	QTY
Assault Cannons	1.00	3
Electropole	0.75	3
Blester	0.50	10
Total CKM =		10.25

Upgrade to Boomes?		
Weapons	CKM	QTY
Boomes	1.25	3
Electropole	0.75	3
Blester	0.50	10
Total CKM =		11.00



Replace some Blesters with Assault Cannons?		
Weapons	CKM	QTY
Assault Cannons	1.00	6
Electropole	0.75	3
Blester	0.50	7
Total CKM =		11.75

**Takeaway:** Increase frequency caps per buyer instead of raising cpm.

## Tactic #3: Break it Up

The Jawas are trying to maximize their profits based on price per microgram (PPM). Should they sell their stolen droids whole or as parts?

WHOLE:		
MERCHANDISE	PPM	QTY
CP30 DROID	0.5	3
	TOTAL PPM =	1.50

PARTS:		
MERCHANDISE	PPM	QTY
DROID HEAD	0.75	3
DROID LIMBS (SET)	0.50	3
DROID TORSO	0.25	3
	TOTAL PPM =	4.50

**Takeaway:** Break up network tags into tiers for higher yield.
