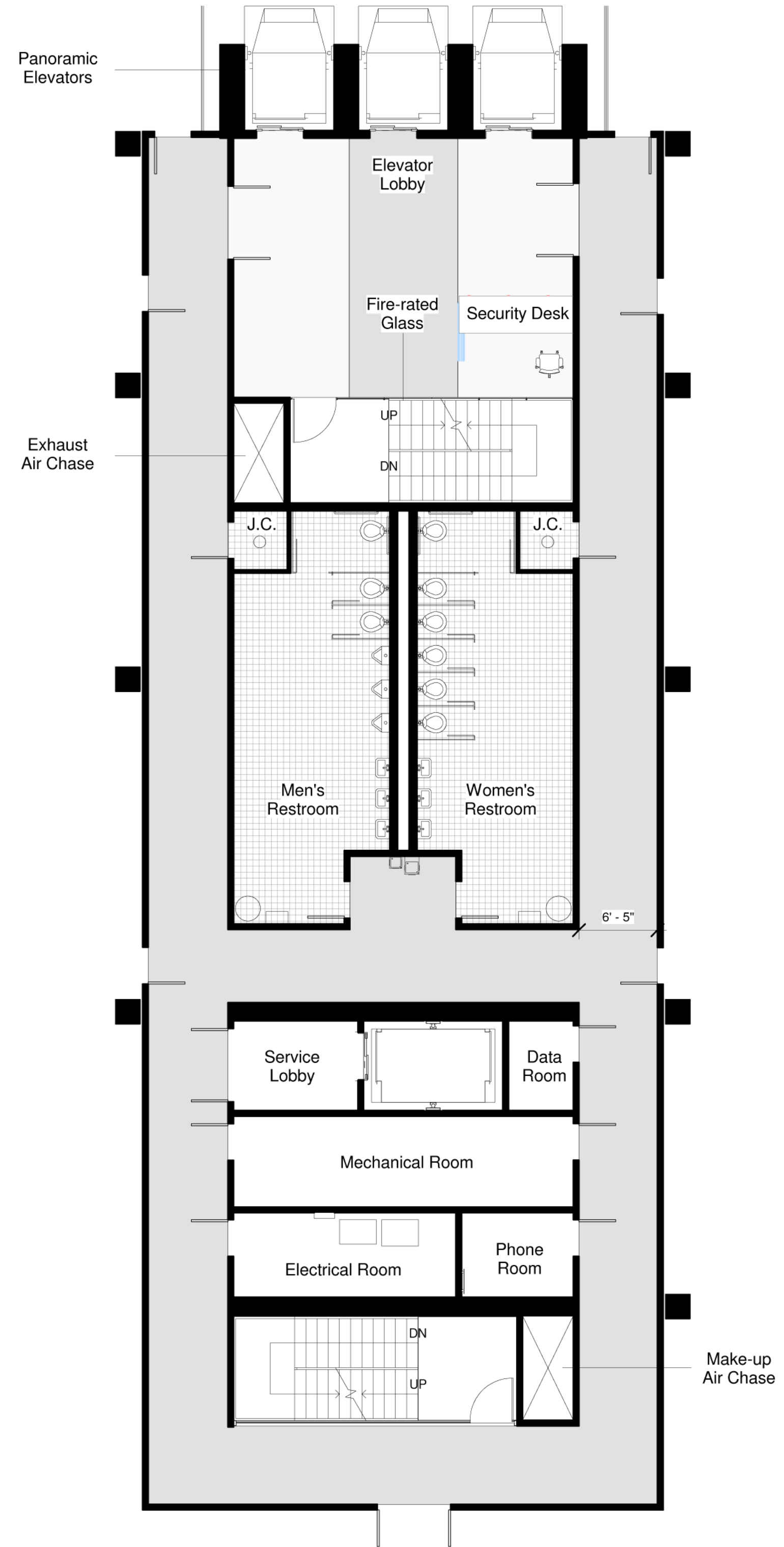


Security

The elevator lobby doors require tenant keycards to access office space. A security desk is located at every prime tenant floor. Upon arrival, a guest checks in with the security desk. The officer then calls an escort for that guest. Before the escort can walk the guest to the appointed area, all computer monitors must be turned off or away from the guest to ensure complete security.

Elevator Lobby

Prime and spec tenants share the same elevator lobby. Each elevator has access to every floor. To allow tenants to more quickly access their desired levels, the floor and elevators are divided into three strips. Two strips give priority to prime tenant floors. These two strips are color coded for Boeing personnel. The middle strip gives priority to spec tenant floors. This strip is color coded for Expedia personnel.

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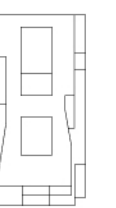
