As a health care consumer, you have choices to make. Medica offers this Provider Directory as a tool to help you easily find a provider that meets your needs and is in the Medica Focus network. To provide more affordable choices, your Medica Focus plan has a limited network of health care providers and facilities in 15 counties, expanding beyond the metro Twin Cities area.

Where to get the most current information.

The information in this directory was compiled on: 07/26/13. To get the most up-to-date look at who is in the Medica Focus network, please use the online search tool at <u>mymedica.com</u> > *Find Physician or Facility.* The online tool is updated weekly and allows you to search for Medica Focus health care providers by location, name and specialty.

Get help finding a network provider that meets your needs. If you're unable to find a provider using this directory or the online tool, call Customer Service using the phone numbers at the bottom of this page.

- Call Monday through Friday, 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. (closed 8–9 a.m. Thursdays) and Saturdays, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.
- Customer Service can also provide this information in Braille or large print.

Important facts about the Medica Focus network.

- It's your choice. You may go to any one of the physicians, specialists and hospitals that are part of the Medica Focus network.
- You do not need referrals. You may see any physician or specialist within the Medica Focus network without a referral.
- To get the highest level of benefits, see network providers. Sometimes even network doctors are not aware that they need to send you to a network hospital for inpatient care. If you need to go to a hospital, work closely with your doctor to choose the most appropriate facility for your needs from within the Medica Focus network. Otherwise, your costs will be much higher and you may be responsible for paying the entire cost of the services you receive. Please contact Customer Service with any questions or to verify an in-network provider or hospital.
- The Medica Focus network is always being updated. Because providers are added to or drop out of the Medica Focus network, this printed edition of the directory may not include the most current information. Before receiving services, please check the online directory or call Customer Service to verify that your doctor is still in the network.

This health plan may not cover all your health care expenses. Please refer to your coverage document for detailed information about your benefits.

How to use this Provider Directory.

Use this directory to find a provider conveniently located for you. The table of contents shows how home clinics, specialists and other providers are organized into sections. Each section is arranged by city, then by clinic name in alphabetical order.

To find a provider:

- 1. Turn to the section for the type of provider you are searching for.
- 2. Choose the city where it would be convenient for you to see a provider.
- 3. Search alphabetically through the clinic names within that city. Each listing includes the clinic address and phone number, and a list of the physicians who practice at that clinic.

Sometimes, a clinic in the network may choose not to accept new patients. However, there are special reasons that you could still go to that particular clinic, such as: (1) You are already a patient at the clinic, but are changing health plans; (2) You are already signed up at the clinic, but have not been seen yet; (3) You are an immediate family member of someone who is a patient at the clinic. **To find out if the clinic will accept you as a new patient, contact the clinic directly.**

Enrolling in this health plan does not guarantee you can see a particular provider on this list. If you want to make sure you can receive care from a specific provider, you should contact Medica Customer Service to ask whether that provider is still a Medica Focus provider (refer to contact information at the bottom of this page). You should also contact the provider's office to find out whether the provider is still accepting patients.

Tips for choosing a provider.

Medica encourages you to establish a long-term relationship with a physician you can trust. A doctor who knows you and your needs can be one of your most valuable health resources.


The most common types of physicians practicing in home clinics include:

- **Family practice physicians.** These doctors specialize in taking care of the general health needs of people of all ages, from infancy through adulthood. They receive a broad range of training in: pediatrics, internal medicine, obstetrics and gynecology, psychiatry and geriatrics.
- Internal medicine physicians. These doctors specialize in diagnosing and treating diseases in adults. They do not perform surgery, deliver babies or treat children.

In case of a medical emergency: Call 911 or go to your nearest hospital emergency room.

- **Obstetricians/Gynecologists (OB/GYN).** These doctors specialize in pregnancy and childbirth and in the diseases and routine care of the reproductive system of women.
- **Pediatricians.** These doctors specialize in taking care of the general health needs of children, from birth through approximately age 16.

It is important to choose the right physician to provide for the health care needs of you and your family. When choosing a doctor, you may want to consider:

- **Training and experience.** Find out whether the doctor is board-certified and whether they have any special training. You can check a doctor's qualifications by using the resources listed below.
- Accessibility. You want your doctor to be available when needed. Ask about office hours, how long it takes to schedule a visit and how patients' afterhours needs are handled. Some providers offer extended hours. Contact your clinic for more information.
- The doctor's approach to preventive medicine. You want a doctor who emphasizes staying healthy. A good indicator of this is if the doctor asks about your eating and exercising habits, smoking, alcohol use and any other health risk factors.
- Additional information about the care system or clinic. Visit the website for the care system or clinic you are considering to find more complete information.
- The care system or clinic's ratings. Visit <u>mnhealthscores.org</u> to view performance measurement and public reports regarding the care and outcomes of patients.

Reassure yourself: Check out a doctor's qualifications.




