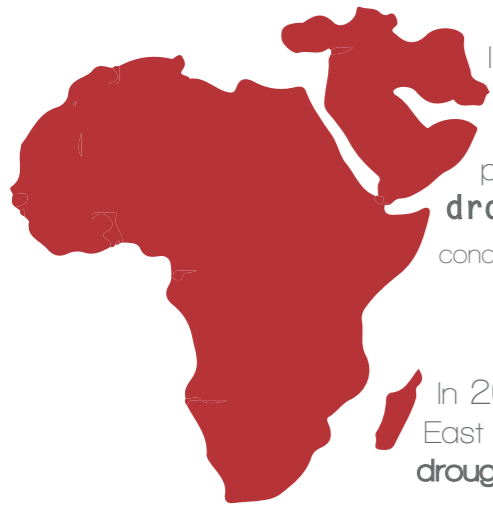

## Drought

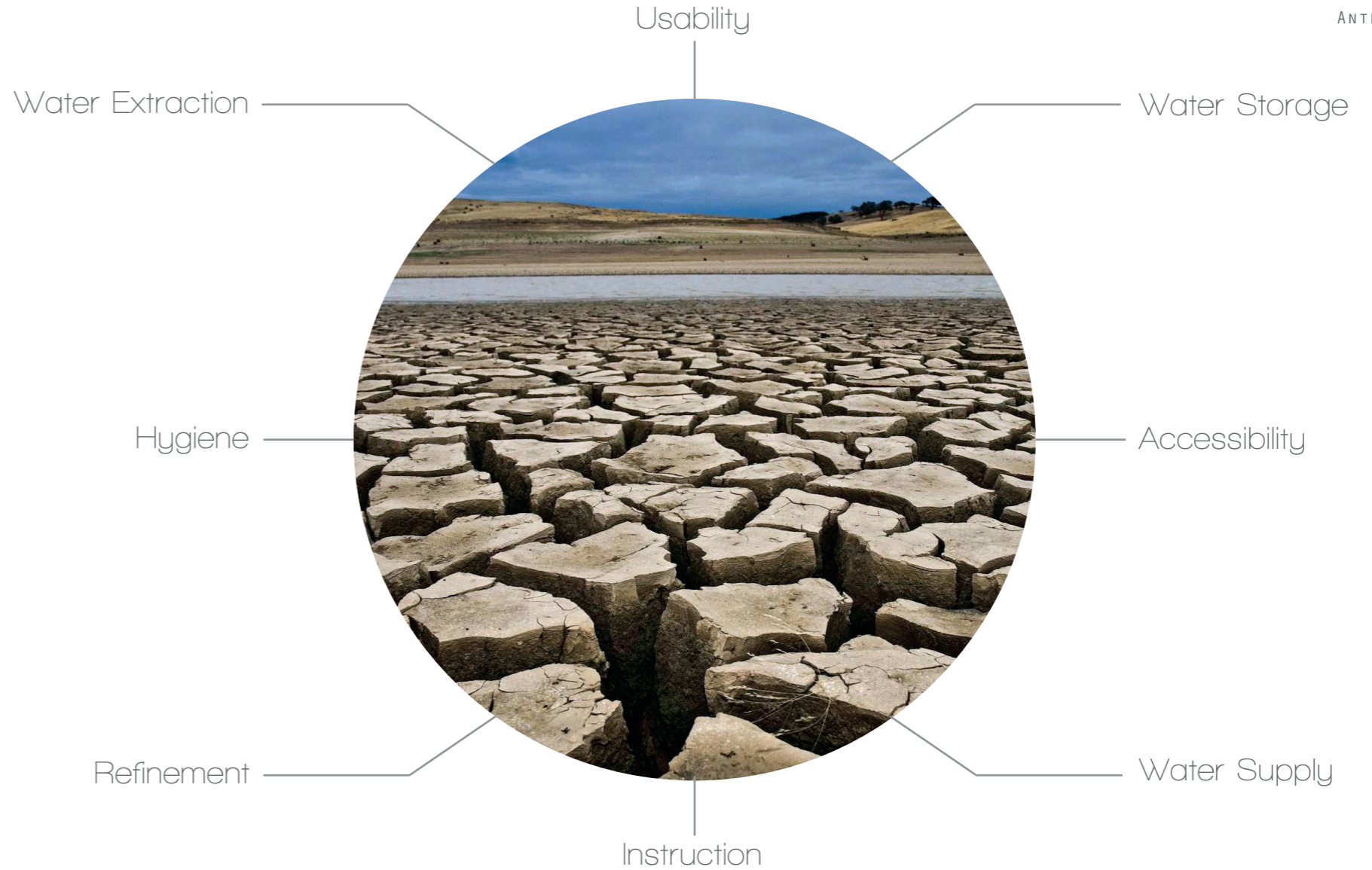

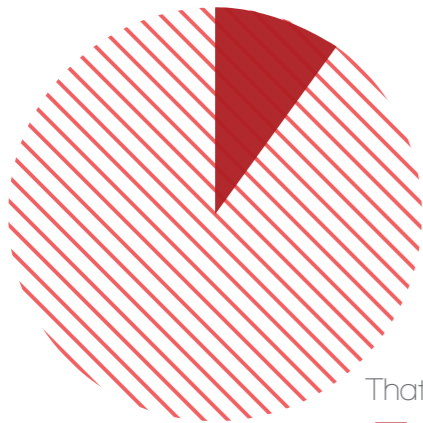
In 2013, **more than 40 Million** people were living in **drought** conditions in East Africa.

**11%** of the **worlds** population has **no** access to **clean** water

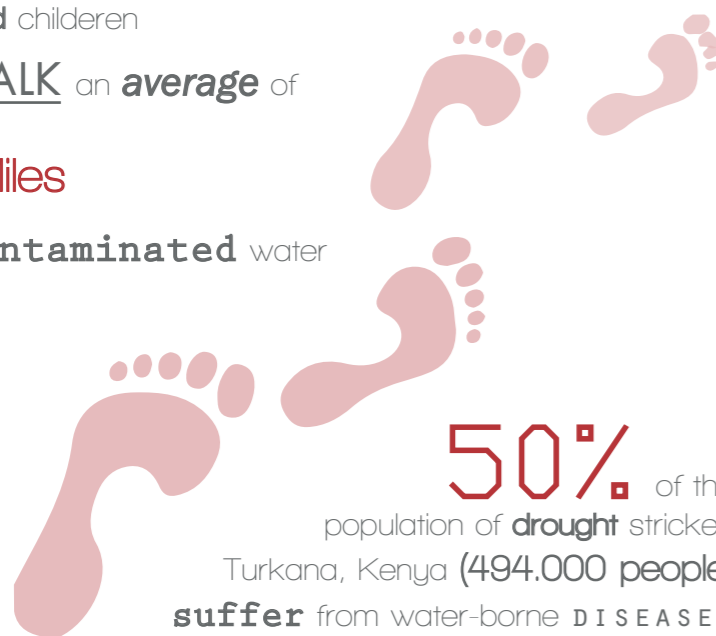


Thats: **780 Million**

**50%** of the population of **drought** stricken Turkana, Kenya (**494.000** people) **suffer** from water-borne **DISEASES**

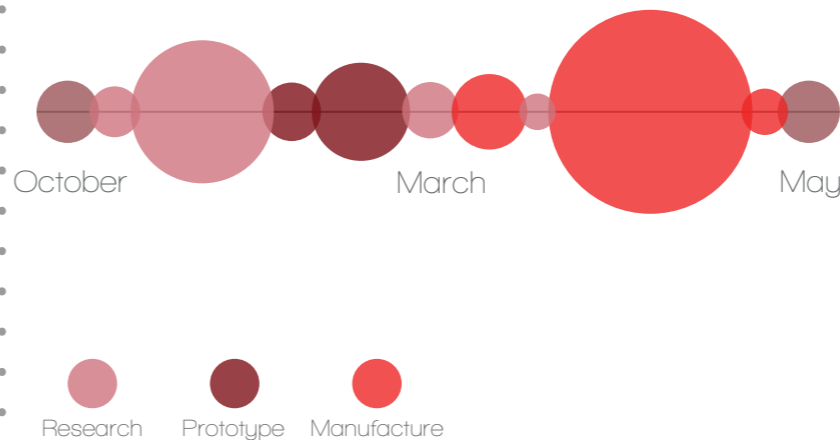
### Insight
