

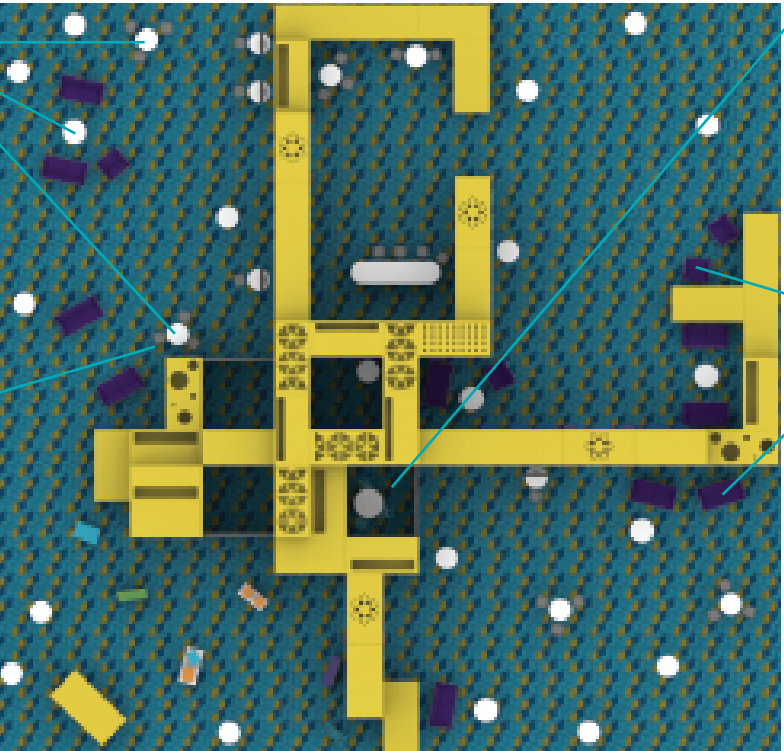
# Furniture Specs

Tulip Tables relate to the previously designed 20x10 exhibit. And reflect the geometric design of the product, but also ties in softer elements with an organic structure. (White)



These tables are utilized throughout the exhibit, giving it a uniform look.

Everything in the exhibit will either reflect the product's design or the brand. Furniture was chosen on how the design reflected product aesthetic or emotive significance. All furniture will be in colors that BOX color options.



Stools are used to encourage short stays in places like charging stations.



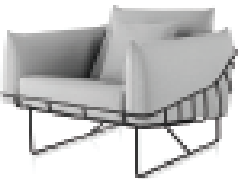
This simple stool will tie together furniture elements while maintaining function. (Grey)
