Like many of you, I had a life changing experience at the Jesuit Spiritual Center. For me it was during my high school senior retreat. It had such an impact on me that the next time I visited the place some ten years later I remember this palpable feeling of peace coming over me as I drove over Cleveland Avenue.



Over the next several decades, whether it was participating in a Personally Directed Retreat, a workshop on some spiritual topic, attending a meeting related to my work, or an Ignatian weekend conference retreat, two things consistently happened: experiencing a spiritual oasis away from the hectic world to stop, reflect, pray and be touched by God; and, that same feeling of peace coming over me as I drove into the Center.

And now – some 50 plus years after I first stood at the overlook on the Little Miami River – the Jesuit Spiritual Center at Milford has become what we on the Board envisioned a few years back: a “Christ-centered oasis where people of *all walks of life* are encouraged to experience a deeper relationship with God.”

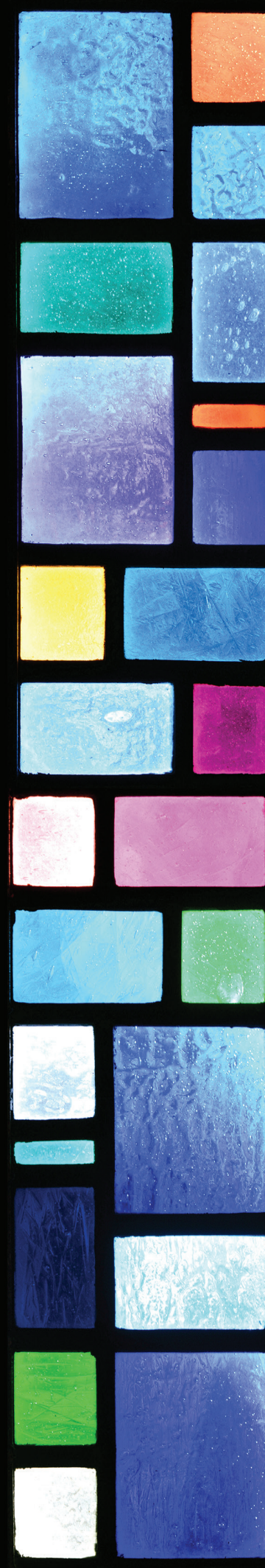

Personally Directed Retreat

These retreats are the oldest tradition at Jesuit retreat houses, going back to the practice of St. Ignatius of Loyola and the first Jesuit companions. St. Ignatius believed that God simply wants to meet us at the core of our lives, in what we most desire: peace, personal freedom, good decisions, living confidently even in hard times. And what helps us most is being able to pray about these things with the encouragement of a caring and open listener, meeting with us each day.

People come for three or four days or a full week, people like you, with different needs and

hopes, in their early thirties or middle years or retirement. You set your own schedule for prayer. The companionship of your personal retreat director helps even beginners to use the time well. And we find that the silence brings people together in a new kind of strength.

The prayer methods of St. Ignatius' *Spiritual Exercises* take you deep into the Bible, the psalms, the life of Jesus. It's like meeting the Lord as if for the first time. It is all for the sake of discovering a new knowledge of your own goodness, to notice God actually as part of your life, and to respond and follow.

Working as a team, we have asked women what they wish to experience and how we can facilitate retreats that will help them grow in their faith and de-stress from their busy lives. We listened, and have been delighted to hear their feedback after experiencing our overnight, daytime and evening events. The truest testimony about the impact of our Women's Spirituality Program comes directly from one retreatant: "The best thing about this weekend was being at peace with myself."

Youth Retreats

Over 6,000 young people yearly through the Jesuit Spiritual Center youth ministry have been invited to "Come and See" where God is in their life. Through these youth retreats we have the privilege to witness young people experience a personal transfiguration. Like the disciple who climbed Mount Sinai, the young people encounter Jesus like they never have before. The youth ministry retreat teams invite today's youth to experience Jesus through the Examen from the *Spiritual Exercises of St. Ignatius of Loyola* and through



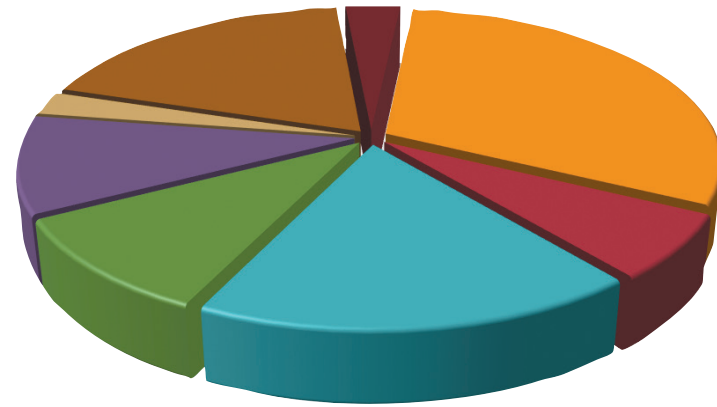

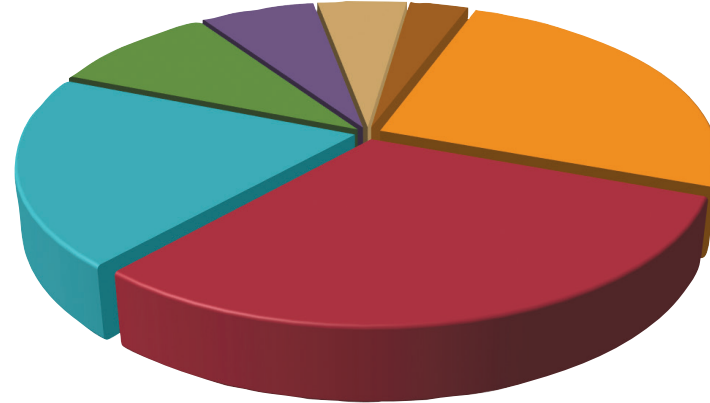

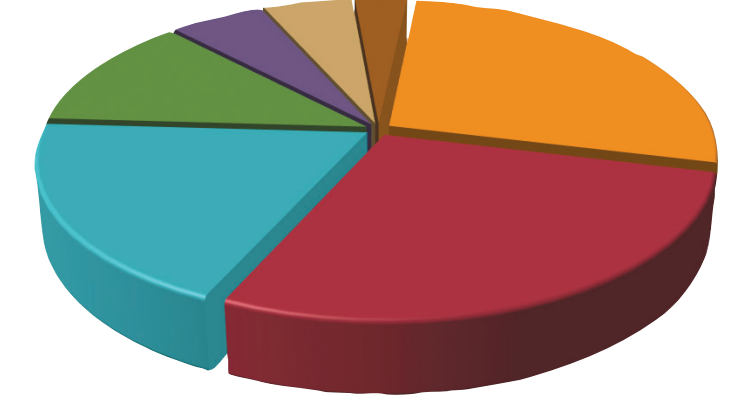
