Azure Grape Hyacinth

The bell-shaped flowers of these fragrant, bright blue charmers open more widely at the base than the traditional blue grape varieties for a fluffier look. Closed flower buds encircle the middle of the flower cone that is crowned by a smaller wreath of flowers. Hardy and carefree, these low-growing beauties easily spread into thick masses that make excellent ground covers. Plant anywhere in sun or shade for a striking effect that resembles Holland's best growing fields.

Balloon Flower

Exceptionally long vase life.

Noted for its lengthy summer to early fall bloom time and ability to thrive in poor soils from dry to damp, partial shade to full sun.


Sorbet Peony
