

Hoboken Engine Company #2 Assembly of Exempt Fireman

Engine Company # 2 is located at 1313 Washington Street. Built in the year 1890, this was the first firehouse built in the city that would be used by paid fireman. The building is now being used by both Ladder Company # 1 and Engine Company # 1. Along with the other firehouses in Hoboken, their job is to keep the city safe from any fires!



The Assembly of Exempt Fireman is located at 213 Bloomfield Street. Built in 1870, this building was originally a place where fireman with 7 years of voluntary service could go to meet. Today, it is used as Hoboken's Firefighter Museum. Inside you can find antique protective fire equipment and a real life firetruck from 1932!
