In- Home Nursing Care

RN's, LPN's, Home Health Aides and Companions are available for any length of time, from occasional brief visits up to 24 hours per day depending on patient and family needs.

In-Home Therapy

Physical Therapist, Occupational Therapist and Speech Pathologists can provide rehabilitative services in the patient's home.

Facility Nursing Care

We provide one-to-one nursing care for individuals that may need extra help or supervision while in the hospital or nursing home.

Assisted/Independent Living

Interim HealthCare offers a wide range of support services for Assisted/Independent living facilities including short or long term personal care services, home health aides, skilled nurses, medication reminders, medical care coordination and supplemental staffing.

Case Management

All clients are assigned to a primary nurse that assists with identifying important needs for comprehensive in-home care. This includes analysis of resources and reimbursement programs to help pay for the cost of care, thorough explanations of available alternatives and information regarding the Medicare and Medicaid programs. The goal of this service is to provide the best quality care at the most reasonable cost for the client and family, and to monitor ongoing service utilization.

Diagnostic Testing

Nurses are available to assist in obtaining blood samples, physical assessments and even heart monitoring tests (EKG's) for individuals in their homes. This can be a very cost-effective service by preventing the need for transporting the patient to a clinic or hospital.

Medical Equipment

Our care management nurses will assist patients in obtaining any necessary adaptive equipment (wheelchairs, walkers beds, etc.)
