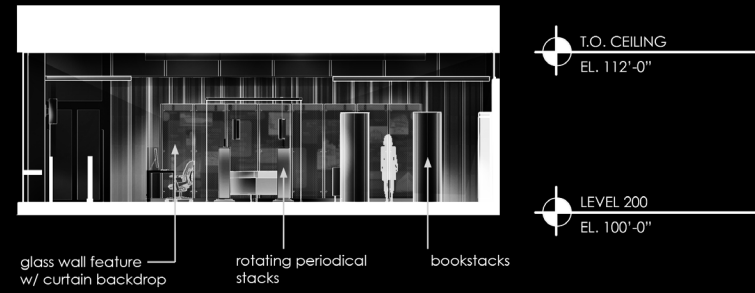
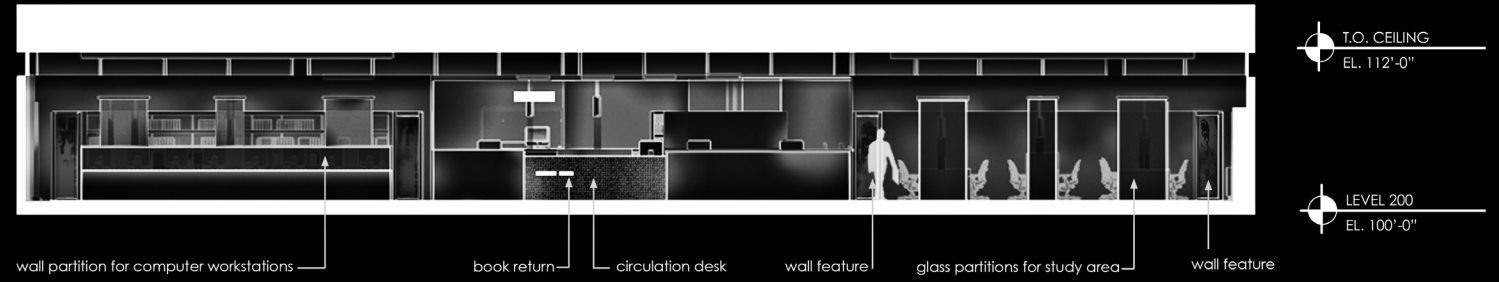


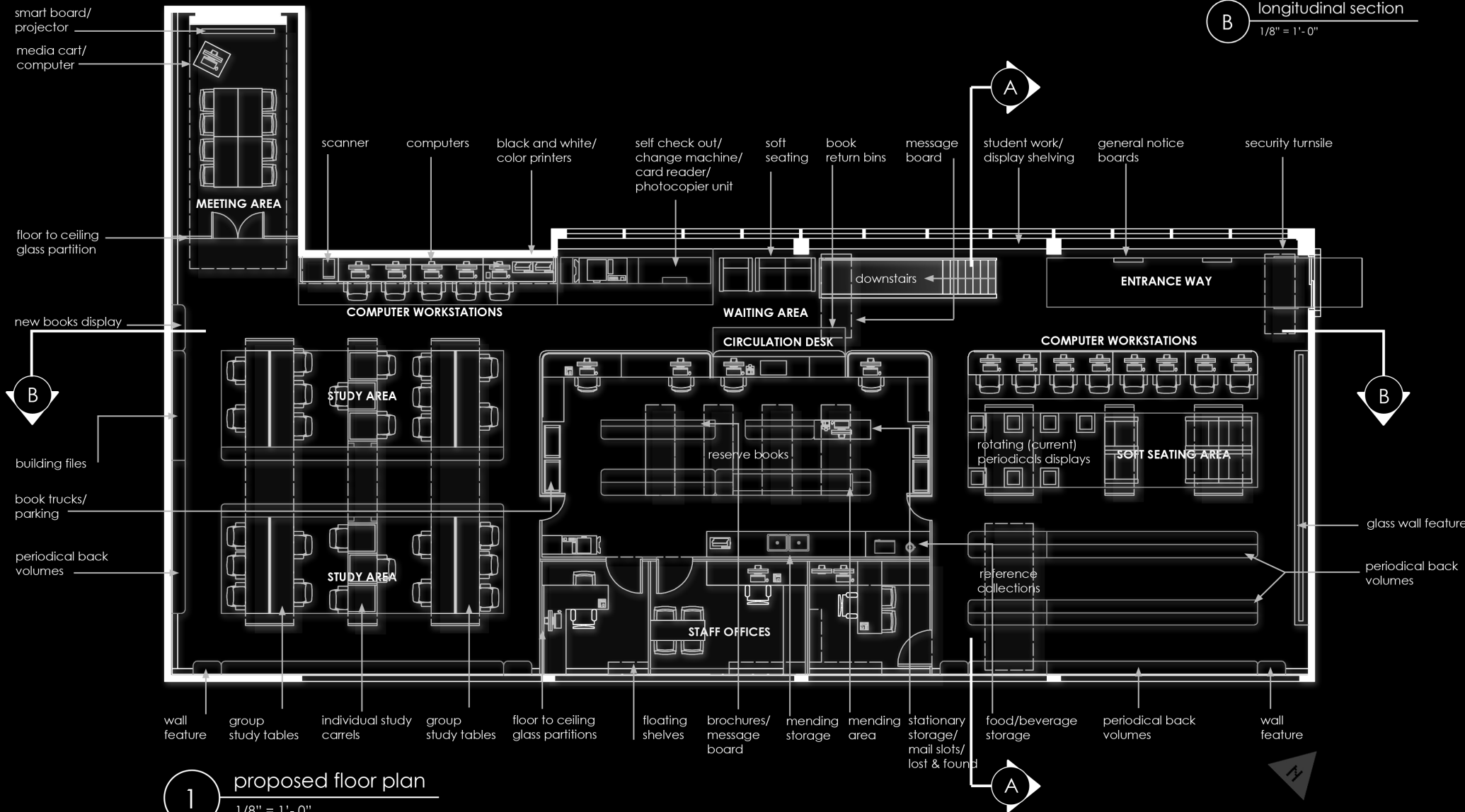
isometric view
