**Diagnosis**

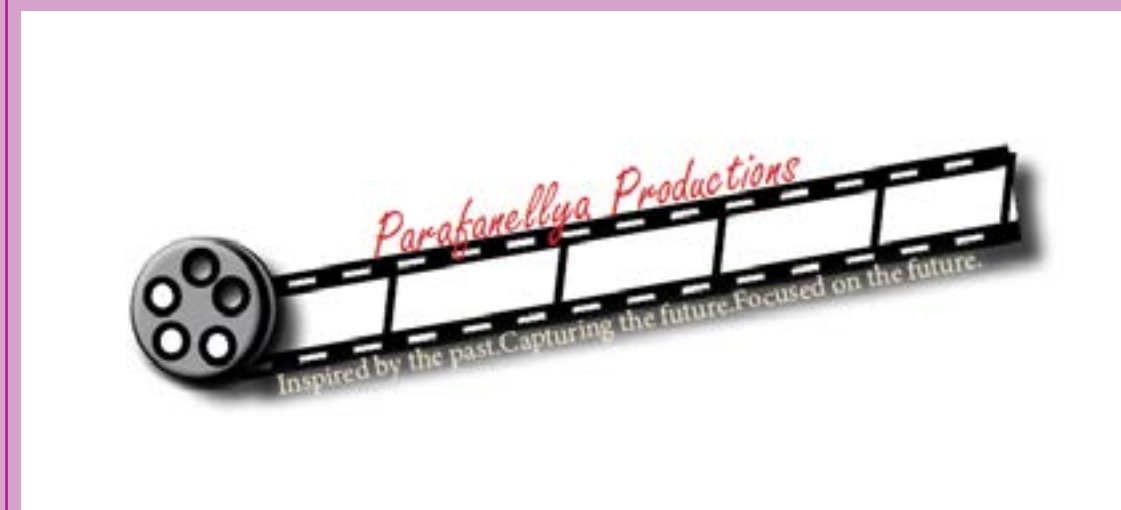
