

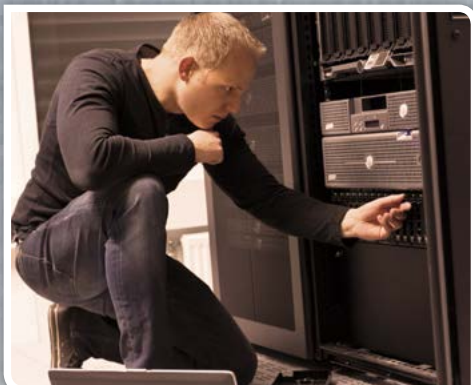

Diploma in Computer Support Specialist

Diploma in MCITP Network Management

The focus on Microsoft networking helps prepare students to take the Microsoft MCITP Enterprise Administrator exams.

Diploma in Network and Server Administration

The focus on Microsoft and Cisco networking helps prepare students to take the Microsoft MCITP Server Administrator exams and Cisco CCNA certifications.
