

scoop on history. Handcrafted by artisans in the Indian village Pratapgad, these polished brass forms revive a traditional style of cooking spoon from India's 16th-century Mughal Era. Historically, every dish in India is served with a specific ladle. Joined by a brass ring for wall display, this sculptural trio

includes the smallest for *ghee* (clarified butter), the medium for *curd* (yogurt) and the largest for *dal* (lentils). For decorative use only.
