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nahuala celebrates the intricately embroidered *huipiles* of Guatemala, traditional loose-fitting tunics worn by indigenous women to represent specific regions of the country. A modern interpretation of huipiles, this beaded wall art is handmade in the highlands of Guatemala in a time-intensive process. Local artisans string glass beads one-by-one on a traditional comb loom to create a geometric composition of pattern and texture. Our collaboration with this initiative helps to provide artisans with sustainable employment to support the missions of Feed the Future and Save the Children.®
