

LOCATION

Set in the cultural heart of New Mexico's capital, the Inn is situated just steps from the city's galleries, shops, museums and the historic Santa Fe Plaza. The surrounding area offers activities for the adventurous spirit with seasonal pursuits such as hiking, mountain biking, skiing, white-water rafting and golf; popular destinations such as Canyon Road, Taos and Bandelier National Park are all within driving distance.

ACCOMMODATION

The Inn features 57 rooms and one suite, all with handcrafted furnishings, traditional wooden ceilings and kiva fireplaces.

MEETINGS & EVENTS


