ISLAND ATTRACTIONS

• Over half of the island of St. John was brought under the U.S. National Park system in the 1950s. Ever since, the park has remained a sanctuary in which wildlife, natural beauty and historic sites are preserved for all who visit St. John. Caneel Bay lies within the boundaries of the park.

St. John boasts over 20 hiking trails. They vary from well-traveled and marked paths to rugged, secluded treks. The Reef Bay Trail is the most famous boasting ruins of four sugar estates, an array of interesting flora and fauna, and the Arawak Indian petroglyphs along its path.
Caneel Bay is home to seven magnificent beaches — picturesque Scott, stunning Turtle Bay, pristine Honeymoon, active Caneel Bay, intimate Paradise, inviting Little Caneel and untamed Hawksnest. There's one to explore for each day of the week.

Trunk Bay, just a short drive from the resort, is one of the Caribbean's most photographed beaches and features a self-guided, underwater snorkeling tour.
The ruins of the 1870's Annaberg Sugar Mill, consisting of Danish stone, coral and brick, have been restored by the National Park. The mill is one of the island's best-preserved examples of its cultural past.
Ruins of the first Moravian church, built in 1749 by the first Protestants to minister to West Indians, can be explored at Estate Bethany.

 On St. John, there are numerous quaint shopping areas around Cruz Bay to explore on foot such as Mongoose Junction and Wharfside Village. A ferry ride to the island of St. Thomas opens doors to almost unlimited shopping options from designer houses to bargain vendors.

GOLF

Golf Digest proclaimed Mahogany Run Golf Course more of an engineering marvel than an architectural one as the course had to be carved and blasted into an area of land just less than 110 acres. With only 77,000 square feet of greens and tight winding fairways, this is target golf with beautiful ocean views culminating in the course's Signature holes known as The Devil's Triangle.

Open seven days a week, Mahogany Run is the only golf course on the island of St. Thomas, in the beautiful US Virgin Islands. The public course is located approximately 20 minutes from the cruise ship docks in the town of Charlotte Amalie and only 15 minutes from the ferry dock at Red Hook.

DINING

Built on the ruins of a Danish plantation house, the Equator Restaurant offers breathtaking views and grilled Caribbean specialties. Casual diners will enjoy the relaxed open-air beachfront setting of the Caneel Beach Terrace or the informal Caneel Bay Bar.

Additionally, Cruz Bay restaurants are available for booking through the Catering and Conference Services Department.



TRAVEL DETAILS

Situated on a 170-acre peninsula surrounded by the beauty of the Virgin Islands National Park and seven beaches, Caneel Bay is located on St. John, a leisurely 35-minute boat ride from St. Thomas.

Flights are available directly to St. Thomas on American Airlines, Continental Airlines, Delta Airlines, U.S. Airways and United Airlines as well as other major carriers. Consult your travel professional for airline reservations. Upon arrival at the St. Thomas airport, please go to the baggage claim area and you will find our reception lounge on the right. We will assist with your luggage and escort you to our private ferry. The ferries operate on a regular schedule, and your guests will be escorted to the next departure, normally within 60 minutes of their arrival. The resort's ferries can also be reserved for private transfers for your group at an additional cost, and satellite check-in at our airport lounge in St. Thomas can be arranged for larger parties. Transfer fees include taxi transfer and ferry transport, plus unlimited round-trip use of the resort's ferries between St. Thomas and St. John during your event. Locally operated taxis are readily available for hire at the resort entrance.
