Site is laid out on an imaginary grid, each cell 80 x 80 pixels


Use of Hierarchy

Landing Page


Initial Confidence

The site uses 'landing pages' to make sure the user is clear about every action they take – no 'hidden surprises' like downloading files or jumping to external resources.

When first using the site, this makes them feel at ease when exploring the site, and encourages them to look deeper.

Options

The user is always given options on a landing page, it helps them out, and teaches them about other functions they might not have discovered.

The telephone directory is on a functional level, almost exactly the same as HTML one used before the implementation of Nucleus. The graphics have been updated to both fit in with the rest of the resource, and be easier on the eyes.
