RULES

Today's format is a **Four Person Scramble**. All players will play a ball from the teeing grounds as follows:

- *All Men will play from the WHITE tees.*
- *All Ladies will play from the RED tees.*

All subsequent shots will be played from the position of the "best ball" as selected by the team as follows:

- *Ball to be placed within one club length, no closer to the hole, of the position of the selected ball.*
- *Should the selected ball be in a bunker, sand may be raked and the ball placed.*
- *Should the selected ball be within the area of a hazard, all balls will be played from a position similar to that of the selected ball.*

In the event a team consists of only 3 players, the players will alternate hitting 2 shots. For example, the first player hits 2 tee shots, the second player hits 2 fairway shots, and the third player putts 2 times. Continue to alternate until the hole is completed with a different player hitting 2 shots each time.

For the consideration of all, we ask for your cooperation in maintaining your place in the field.
