



# ARTHRITIS, OR JOINT INFLAMMATION, IS THE MOST COMMON CAUSE OF DISABILITY IN AMERICA, AFFECTING 22.2% OF ADULTS

The number of those affected is expected to rise from 50 million to 67 million by 2030

Rheumatoid Arthritis affects approximately 1.5 million Americans

Affects 2.5 times as many women as men

42.4% report arthritis-attributable activity limitation (AAAL)

**Morning joint stiffness with RA lasts for at least 30 minutes and can persist for hours, complicating morning activities and daily hygiene routines.**
