Both issues causing early death to these beautiful animals.

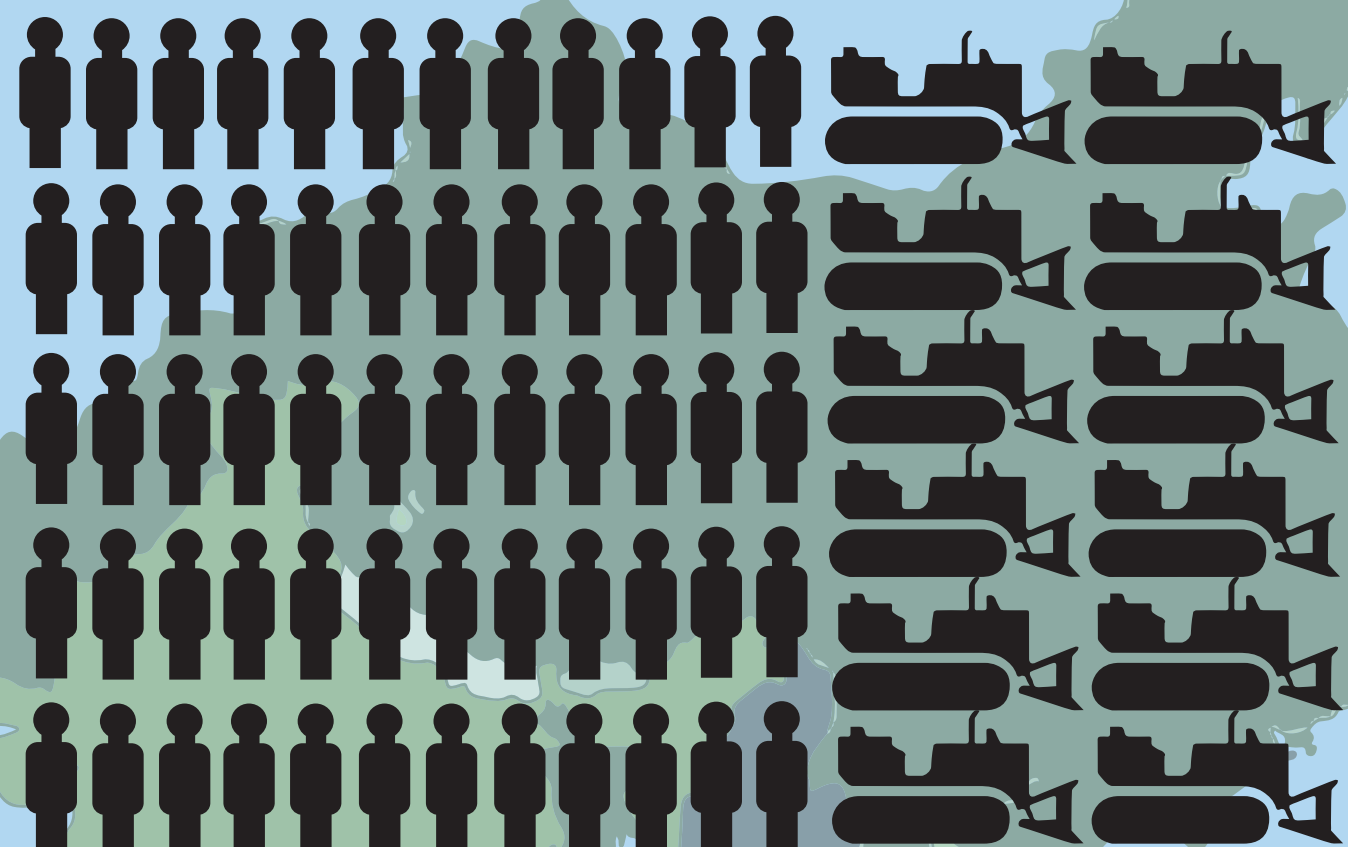
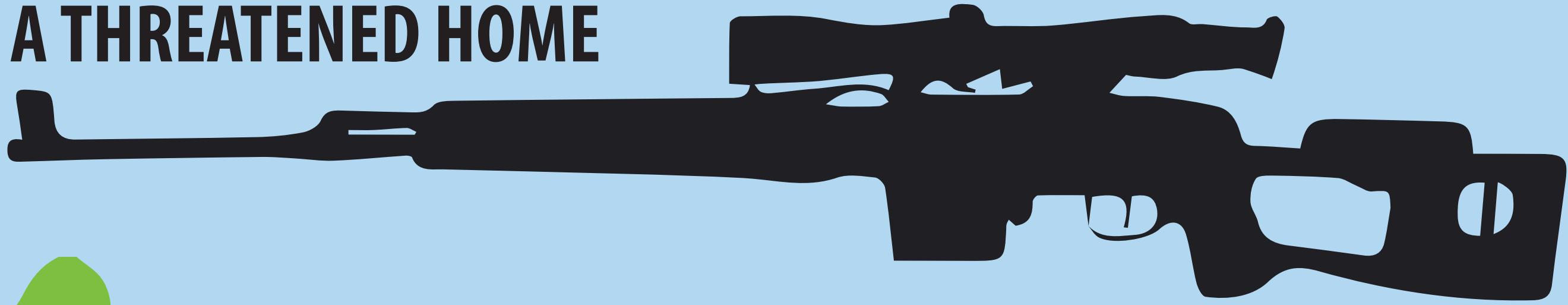

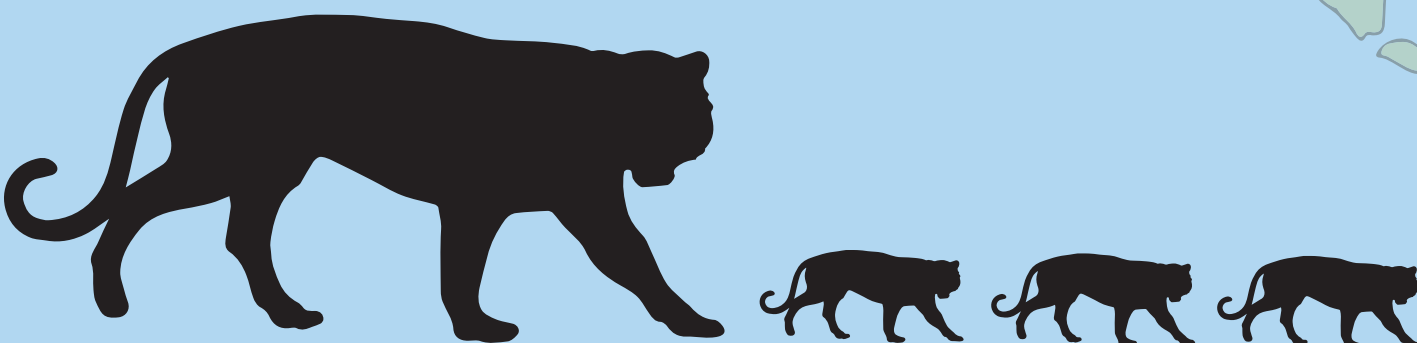

Humans are taking over the habitat that used to be the main stomping grounds of the Asian Tiger. Retaliatory killings, poaching, and deforestation is slowly confining them to a smaller and smaller habitat, making them even more vulnerable.



Female tigers will have a litter every 2-2.5 years. Each litter has 2-3 cubs. Many do not survive.

Tigers can live up to 26 years in the wild.

Population: Less than 3,200
Weight: 220-660 lb
Habitat: Tropical rainforest, swamps, savanna, grasslands.
