Personal Narrative

I'm a radiation oncologist, also serving as an Associate Professor of Radiation Oncology. Prior to OSU, I was a staff specialist in radiation oncology at the National Institutes of Health Clinical Center in Bethesda, Maryland.

I feel privileged to be part of The Ohio State University medical community, and I'm especially proud to contribute to the overall OSUCCC-James mission: cutting-edge research and the delivery of superior, personalized care to each and every one of our patients and their families.

A lot of my work has been in clinical and laboratory research, evaluating everything from the effectiveness of ionizing radiation treatments to trials aimed at determining ways to mitigate the undesired side-effects of certain treatment regimens. It is my hope that this and the other research we do will not only help us ultimately wipe out cancer, but also ease the suffering of patients while we're on the way to achieving that goal.

I've contributed to 17 peer-reviewed publications, which cover topics ranging from therapies to treat bone and extremity soft-tissue sarcomas to the tomography-based radiation therapy of ovarian remnants for symptomatic persistent endometriosis. I have also published seven presentations.

In addition to my work at OSUCCC-James, I am a Primary Laboratory Investigator, mentoring radiation oncology fellows and students at the National Cancer Institute.
