At 1642 dropped starboard anchor in 9 fathoms of water in berth B-169 Nakagusuku Wan, Okinawa, Ryukyu Islands.

At 1755 a yard tug relieved this vessel of tow, BCL 1105.

At 1807 shifted anchorage to berth B-184.

11 June 1945:

Anchored as before.

At 0920 the YP 41 moored along our starboard side for repairs to her bottom.

At 1315 the YP 41 departed from alongside.

At 1900, flash red, sounded general quarters.

At 1907 four (4) enemy aircraft reported closing from the northeast distance seven miles.

At 1910 opened fire with 20MM's on Japanese dive bomber (Val) attaching ships in the anchorage.

At 1913 checked fire. Enemy aircraft shot down by ships in the anchorage, crashing into the water six hundred and ten (610) yards bearing 1900 relative from this vessel.

At 1952, flash white, all clear, secured from General Quarters. Twenty millimeter gunners reported two hundred
