contemporary Florida!*



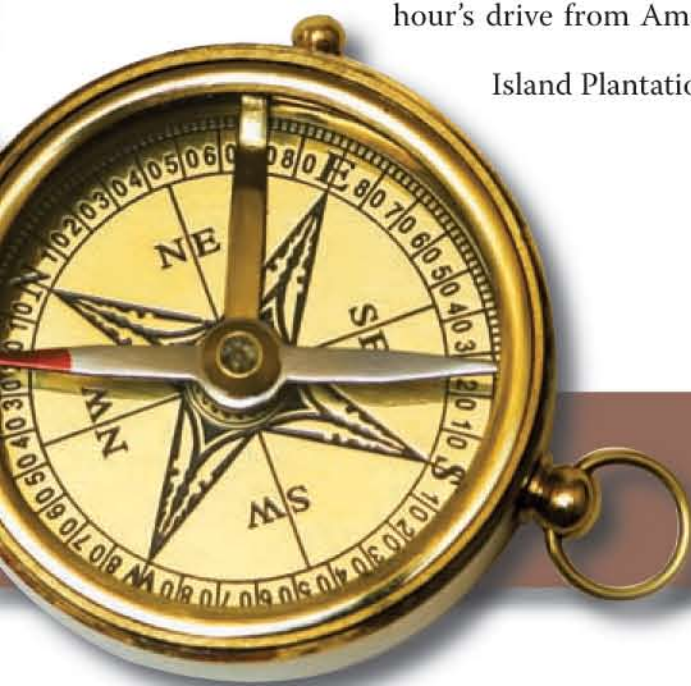
