Our services are available in a 17 county region in upstate New York that includes Albany, Clinton, Columbia, Dutchess, Essex, Franklin, Fulton, Greene, Hamilton, Montgomery, Rensselaer, Saratoga, Schenectady, Schoharie, Ulster, Warren, and Washington counties.

Our Services Include



Criminal Justice Initiative

Provides Peer Education for inmates in designated NYS correctional facilities and linkage and navigation services for inmates who have HIV/AIDS or hepatitis C during incarceration and in preparation for release.



Emerging Communities

Case management services and health education groups provided for men who have sex with men.



Health Home

Case management for those with chronic medical conditions who currently have Medicaid.



Health Insurance Access Program

Assists individuals with enrollment into comprehensive health insurance plans including Medicare, Medicaid, and the New York State of Health Marketplace.



HIV, STI, & Hep C Testing

Offering free and confidential HIV, STI, and hepatitis C counseling, testing and referral services.



Housing Retention Services

Helps those with chronic illnesses who are homeless or unstably housed maintain safe and affordable housing.



Linkage to Care

Our Link2Care program helps connect people living with or at risk for HIV/AIDS and have fallen out of medical care.



Nutrition Services

Nutritional assistance for those with chronic illnesses including food pantry bags and food vouchers. Our Food4Life program provides education and services for people living with HIV/AIDS including nutritional assessments, food pantry bags and food vouchers.



Ryan White Case Management*

A program for those living with HIV/AIDS who need access to medical and support services.



Transportation

Bus tokens, gas cards, and coordination of taxi rides for those with chronic illnesses to access needed services.



Women's Program

Link2Care and group education (SELF) services are available for women who are living with or at high-risk for HIV, STI's, or HCV.
