BLS SESSIONS FOR EMD'S & ETC'S AT DRDE ACADEMY

The training covered essential skills such as Basic Life Support. CPR and choking management skills were taught to participants to deal with emergencies on day to day basis.

BASIC LIFE SUPPORT TRAINING FOR STATION MANAGEMENT

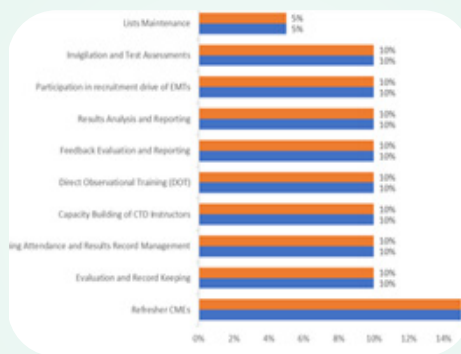
