In parallel was designed and detailed collectively a scheme which incorporated a series of centrally suspended central kite- like structures via 35 meter long steel cranes which acted as cantilevers hanging central kites being tied back down to street level. The kites offered a distinct character to the central space internally playing with form and light through the language of bespoke Architecture.
