Redwood park rangers created all the content for the new National Park Service Mobile App. Our content includes three California State Parks and Redwood National Park.



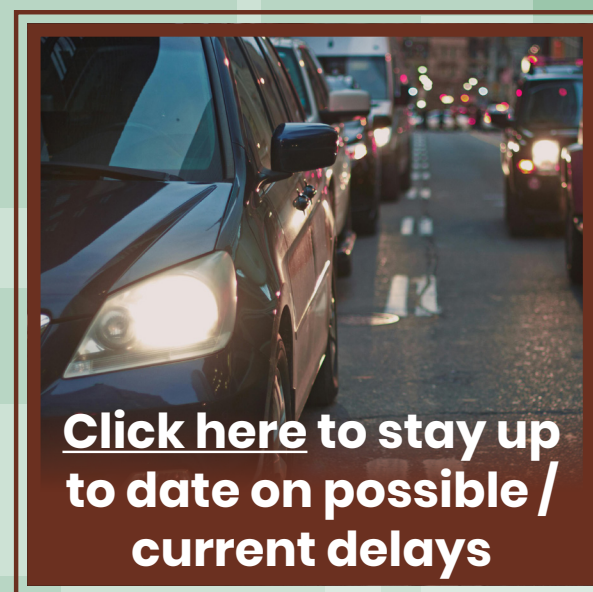
Sleeping & Eating

Prepare for Delays

Make sure to read the current conditions page on our website and check the "Alerts" on the mobile app. For example, there may be construction delays on HWY 101. There might be smoke in the air, or there might be campfire restrictions, or T-Rexes on the loose.



Camping & Lodging

The only way to spend the night in the parks is to stay at a developed campground (reservations recommended), or hike to a backcountry campsite (free permit required). We have no hotels or lodges in the park. There are plenty of lodging and camping options outside the park.
