Design Analyst Duties & Responsibilities

Responsibilities for design analyst

- Master the use and applications of the technology used in the proposal and portfolio management processes
- Working as a team, monitor and address all Desktop Publishing requests as a matter of urgency
- Develop Sales and Marketing material that enhances the client experience
- Support & develop Marketing & Branding tools that enhance the employee experience
- Address opportunities to improve communications effectiveness of material as appropriate
- Works closely with end users to identify GIS requirements, technical issues and training needs
- Analyzes requests for a variety of new applications, programs and modifications to existing GIS programs
- Designs, implements, and tests configuration changes in packaged software such as ESRI and Oracle to meet end user business requirements
- Tests new and revised programs and interfaces to ensure accuracy and efficiency
- Coordinates and conducts user applications training classes
