Monaco

The high-octane **Formula 1 Grand Prix de Monaco** (May 23 to 26, 2019) returns to the iconic Monte Carlo street circuit next year.



Stay


The location of **Hôtel de Paris**'s (Montecarlosbm.com) Casino Square is perfect for accessing the racetrack, and inside it is all Belle Époque grandeur. Or book a suite at **Hôtel Hermitage**, if you'd like a racetrack view from your windows, plus a chef on call.



Park Hyatt Tokyo

Fans of *Lost in Translation* will instantly recognise **Park Hyatt Tokyo** in Shinjuku, a 10-minute drive from the New National Stadium. The hotel rooms offer stunning views of the city (on a clear day, you can even see Mount Fuji). Take inspiration from the Olympics, and head to their Club on the Park to clock laps at the pool (Hyatt.com).

Eat

Monte Carlo is teeming with Michelin-starred tables like the three-starred **Le Louis XV** by **Alain Ducasse** (Ducasse-paris.com), considered the best in French dining. At **Monte Carlo Beach Hotel** (Montecarlosbm.com), try an al fresco meal at **Le Vistamar** or visit **Elsa**, the first all-organic restaurant to receive a star.

Play

The ultimate Monte Carlo experience is getting to watch the F1 from a private yacht; charter your own from **Camper & Nicholsons** (Camperandnicholsons.com) or **International Yacht Register** (Iyr.net). Join the F1 drivers at the VIP after-party at **Amber Lounge** (Amber-lounge.com) and reserve one of the **Jeroboam** tables, where the champagne is always free-flowing.



Sushi Sho

Eat

You haven't had sushi until you've had it in Tokyo! Try **Sushi Sho** in Shinjuku (Sushi-sho.com), or the three-Michelin-starred **Sushi Yoshitake** in Ginza (Sushi-yoshitake.com). Dive into a comforting bowl of yuzu ramen at **Afuri** in Shinjuku (Afuri.com), or head to **Fuunji** in Shibuya for tsukemen (+81-3-6413-8480).

Take a private tour of Tokyo's indie shops with **Michi Travel**'s local guide to find out what's on trend (Michitravel.com). Art lovers, head to **3331 Arts** in Chiyoda (3331.jp) or **Mori Art Museum** at Roppongi (Mori.art.museum) for the latest in contemporary art.
