## **ONE LONG-DISTANCE** TRAIL TO UNDERTAKE

"The Lycian Way is a 500km-long hiking trail that winds its way along southern Turkey's Turquoise Coast, passing ancient amphitheatres, churches, drowned cities, and stone sarcophagi. The trail, stitched together from old walkways and goatherd tracks by British historian Kate Clow, gives walkers access to Lycian ruins as well as island-studded bays that are only reachable by foot or boat. The route also meanders through olive groves, where you may meet flocks of glossy goats, a wild boar or two, and forests of woody bushes. But the trail doesn't offer up her glories easily-at times you'll be scrambling over sharp rock and clinging onto rope past tombs carved into cliff faces. Still, it's all worth it for the dive into the sea when you reach your guesthouse or camp site, or the lunch of homemade cheese, olives, bread, and honey in a hilltop village of stone houses. While the full length of the trail, from Fethiye to Antalya, can take a month, many walkers pick a section that can be done in a few days. From the charming town of Kaş, via the paradisiacal getaway of Kaleköy, and onto ruin-studded Demre takes about four days, and offers history and natural splendour in abundance."
