What to bring:


- Pillow, sleeping bag or bedding (for a twin sized bed)

- Bible and pen

- Water bottle (preferably one that can close securely when in a backpack)
- Sunscreen
- Flashlight
- Spending money for the camp store (optional, of course)
- A watch
- Modest swimsuit.
- 2 towels (one for the pool, and one for showering)
- Don't forget to label EVERYTHING!

Directions [just in case]:

BRIDGE IS STILL OUT ON PETERSON ROAD here's how to get to Judson Baptist Retreat Center:

From Hwy 10 Turn North on Hwy 19, Drive through Norwood, and turn Left on Thompson Creek Road (Look for big green Judson Baptist Retreat Center Sign). Drive 7.5 miles on Thompson Creek Road and then turn Left on Peterson Road. Drive 2.9 miles and the Camp entrance is on the left.



What not to bring:

- Inappropriate clothes (clothes that are short or tight, advertises alcohol or tobacco, promotes racism, sexism or hatred of any group or person, or promotes sexual actions or situations)
- Fireworks
- Any weapon (including a pocket knife)
