BIO: Glen Plake is a US National Ski Hall of Fame skier. He grew up in Lake Tahoe, skiing Heavenly Valley. He is known for his trademark often dyed Mohawk hairstyle, Plake was named the pioneer of extreme skiing in America by ESPN.

BIO: Scot Schmidt is a professional extreme skier born in Helena, MT. Scot started skiing professionally in 1983 in Squaw Valley. Scot has appeared in 40 ski movies, becoming a pioneer of extreme skiing.

BIO: Phil is a former World Cup alpine ski racer, widely regarded as one of the greatest American skiers of all time. His total of 27 World Cup race wins is fourth among Americans, only behind Lindsey Vonn, Mikaela Shiffrin, and Bode Miller.

SKIER NAME: Geoff Stump

BIRTHDAY: March 3

80's SKI MOVIES: The Droids, Time Waits for Snowman, The Good, The Rad & the Gnarly, Maltese Flamingo, Blizzards of AHHH's.

BIO: Geoff along with his brother, director Greg Stump, developed content that has become legendary in the ski industry. Geoff has been a 6 time member of the US Freestyle Ski Team.





SKIER NAME: Stein Eriksen

BIRTHDAY: December 11

80's SKI MOVIES: The Heart of Skiing, The Legendary Skier, Steep and Deep, White Magic.

BIO: Eriksen was the first male alpine ski racer from outside the Alps to win an Olympic gold medal. Some of his other accomplishments include the fact that he is credited with devising "aerials", a freestyle skiing event.





SKIER NAME: Billy Kidd

BIRTHDAY: April 13

80's SKI MOVIES: Steep and Deep, Steeper and Deeper.

BIO: Not to be confused with Billy the Kid, Billy became the first American men to win a Olympic medal in alpine skiing, winning silver in the slalom at the 1964 Winter Olympics at Innsbruck. He currently lives in Steamboat Springs, CO and is the Director of Skiing at Steamboat Ski Resort.






SKIER NAME: Warren Miller

BIRTHDAY: October 15

80's SKI MOVIES: Ski People, Ski Time, Ski Country, Steep and Deep, Escape to Ski, White Magic, and many MANY more.

BIO: World's foremost ski filmmaker and a beloved spokesperson for the sport, Warren founded Warren Miller Entertainment. His published works include over 750 sports films.





SKIER NAME: Greg Stump

BIRTHDAY: June 5

80's SKI MOVIES: The Good, the Rad and the Gnarly, Blizzard of AHHH's, License to Thrill, Maltese Flamingo, Time Waits for Snowman, and many more.

BIO: In 1979, Greg won the North American Freestyle Championships at Edelweiss Valley in Quebec. From there he went onto make his own ski and snowboarding movies. In 1999 Skiing Magazine called him one of the 25 most influential people in skiing.





SKIER NAME: John Egan

BIRTHDAY: January 15

80's SKI MOVIES: White Winter Heat, White Magic.

BIO: Egan was first spotted by Warren Miller at Sugarbush, VT, in 1978 and went on to star in over a dozen films. Miller described John as the "boldest and most innovative skier", and likened him to an ATV on skis: a go anywhere, ski anything athlete.
