Innovative Programs

Desensitization Protocol
 For recipients with high antibodies, we provide a desensitization treatment program for patients previously deemed non-transplantable. The program has a 50 percent success rate for transplants.

Single-Incision Donor Nephrectomy
 Our Living Donor program was the second in the nation to provide this surgery. This procedure reduces scarring, healing time and risk of infection.

Kidney/Pancreas Transplant Program
 Our combined Kidney/Pancreas Transplant program opened in 2007. It's the only program in Central Florida to provide specialized kidney/pancreas transplant surgery. Our wait times are much shorter than the national average and among the shortest in Florida.

Pediatric Kidney Transplant Program
 Our surgeons work closely with our pediatric nephrologists and a specially trained clinical team to provide comprehensive care and expertise in treating children with end-stage renal disease.

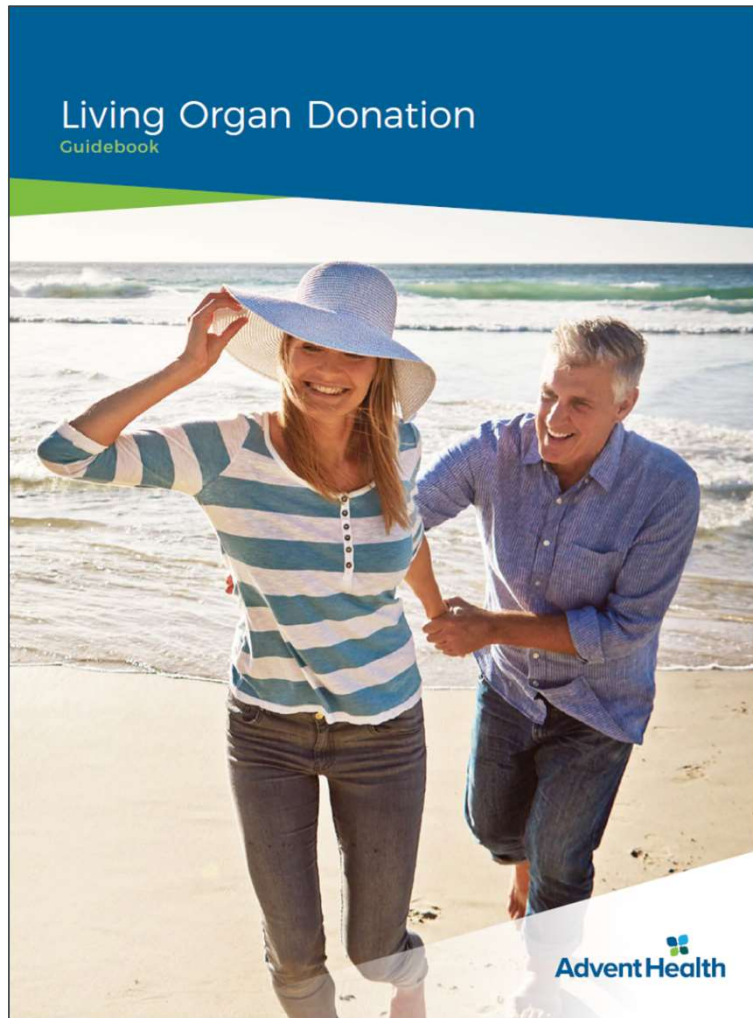

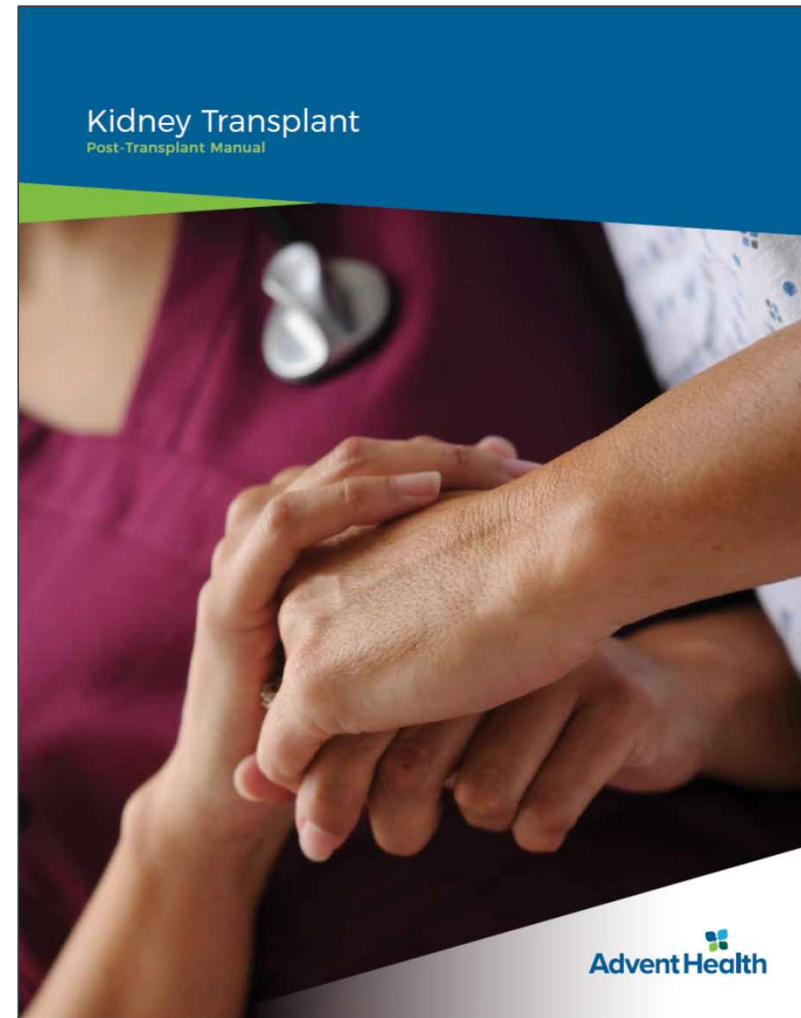
