Providence House provides a faith-based, transitional housing and self-sufficiency program for motivated women with young children who are homeless or at risk of being homeless.

Who We Are

At Providence House, we believe every family deserves a safe place to rebuild and a chance to thrive.

As the oldest provider of transitional housing for women with young children in Collier County, we have dedicated ourselves to helping mothers who are homeless or on the brink of homelessness. We offer not just shelter, but a pathway to independence.

Our mission is rooted in faith, offering hope and practical support through housing, life skills training, and personalized care. Each mother in our program is empowered to take control of her future, providing a brighter, stable environment for her children.



Our Program

Homelessness is not just about losing a home—it's about losing a sense of security, stability, and hope. For the women who come to Providence House, homelessness often results from unforeseen crises—domestic violence, job loss, medical emergencies, or a lack of affordable childcare. These women are often left with no safety net, forced to make impossible choices to provide for their children.

Our two-year transitional housing program is designed to address the underlying challenges that keep women, and their children trapped in cycles of homelessness and poverty. By providing a safe and supportive environment, along with the skills and resources needed for long-term success, we help families move from crisis to self-sufficiency. The women that come to live at Providence House are motivated and ready to work hard for the changes they desire.

The impact of our work extends beyond the families we serve. When a mother becomes self-reliant, her children also flourish. They experience the security of a stable home, the opportunity to excel in school, and the joy of watching their mother succeed. As families grow stronger, so does our entire community.



Our services

ProvidenceHouse provides a comprehensive, two-year program designed to break the cycle of poverty and homelessness. Mothers in our care receive:



Transitional Housing

A beautiful, welcoming, safe, and fully furnished place to call home while working on her plan.



Case Management

Program participants work one-on-one with a Case Manager to develop and implement a plan for success.



Life Skills Learning

Valuable skill-building opportunities foster personal growth and professional enrichment.



Counseling Referrals
