If a donor gives a tangible asset that can be used by the School in its educational programs, the donor receives a charitable deduction equal to the asset's fair market value.

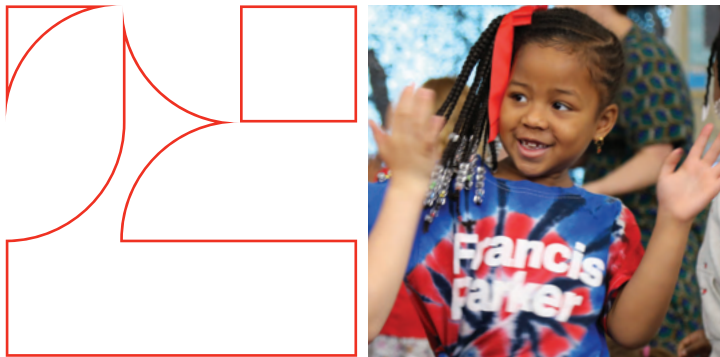
FOUNDERS SOCIETY FOR PLANNED GIVING
