A PALE BLUE DOT

Twenty-six years ago a set of images were taken that provided a unique view of Earth and helped highlight the fragility of our existence, and the importance of our stewardship. As the Voyager 1 planetary spacecraft went beyond the orbit of Pluto on February 14, 1990, it took one last look at Earth. Three exposures, each one in a different filter, contained a very small and faint Earth. The late astronomer Carl Sagan eloquently tried to express how he felt about this photo in his book *Pale Blue Dot*: "Look again at that dot. That's here. That's home. That's us. On it everyone you love, everyone you know, everyone you ever heard of, every human being who ever was, lived out their lives..." The Great Blue Hole is a large underwater sinkhole off the coast of Belize. It lies near the center of Lighthouse Reef, a small atoll 62 miles (100 km) off the mainland. It is a world-class destination for recreational scuba divers. The world's largest natural formation of its kind, the Great Blue Hole is part of the larger Barrier Reef Reserve System and a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

LADY OF THE NORTH

Northumberlandia, also known as the 'Lady of the North', is a huge land sculpture in the shape of a reclining female figure near Northumberland, England. The sculpture is made of 1.5 million metric tons of earth, it is 112 feet (34 m) high and 1,300 feet (400 m) long. Its creators claim it's the largest land art of the female form in the world.
