



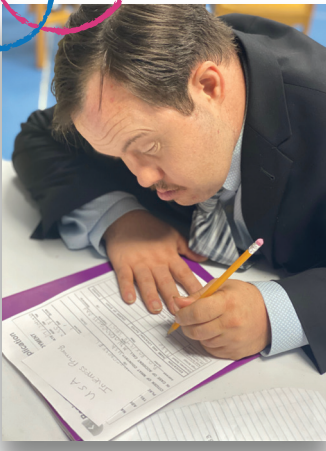

### ADULT DAY TRAINING

The Adult Day Training (ADT) program utilizes outcome-based opportunities that explore each person's strengths as well as their expressed hopes and dreams. On a daily basis, observations and interactions occur with all participants to ensure the services they receive are person-centered and meet their expectations.

### WORK PROGRAM

In the Creative Climbers Workshop, individuals learn new skills, improve existing skills, and enhance their confidence and self-esteem in a work setting. They will engage in a training program and will need to apply and go through a mock interview prior to becoming an official Creative Climber. As minimum wage paid employees of the workshop, they will design and produce custom printed mugs.

### PERSONAL SUPPORT

Personal Support is a one-to-one service that provides opportunities for people to increase their independence and connect with their community. Support can include assistance with daily living activities such as eating breakfast or brushing teeth to participating in local events and building

### SUPPORTIVE LIVING

This service provides training to help the participant acquire and maintain skills that promote independence. Assistance in locating, securing, and maintaining a home. 24/7 wrap-around support with emergency response capabilities, maintaining relationships, support with medical services, and transportation.

### COMPANION CARE

Companion care is a form of home care offering non-medical services to adults with disabilities. Companion care differs from personal care in that personal care aides (also known as home health aides) may provide the same services as companion care but also help with tasks such as bathing, dressing, and medication management, depending on specific state regulations. The goal of companion care is primarily emotional support and socialization, although companions may help older adults with a variety of tasks.

### SOCIAL CLUB

The JTSF Social Club nurtures peer-to-peer interaction time where people can bond and have fun together! Our unique club offers events such as: themed-dinners, game day, movies and musicals. In addition our field trips have taken place at theme parks and nature parks. Individuals can participate in our dances and "surprise night out" events.

### JOB COACHING

We provide structured on-the-job training and support for individuals to adjust effectively to their selected work environment therefore building employment independence.
