






Gus and his family went to the Picnic and Funny Hat Contest at Pumpkin Land. Gus had red and tan dots on his hat, but Gus did not win.




This is Mice City School. It has six grades. Cal is in Grade 2. His pal, Cid, is too. Cal and Cid are in the same grade.


