



Vestibular (balance) diagnostics

The purpose of vestibular diagnostics is to ascertain the health of the vestibular or balance portion of the inner ear, and to determine if dizziness, vertigo or balance issues are caused by ear or central nervous system disorders.

- auditory brainstem response evaluation

- YES NO 8. Do you hear better with one ear than the other?
- YES NO 9. Have you had significant noise exposure at work, recreation or in military service?
- YES NO 10. Do you experience ringing or noises in your ears?
