Big and bulky is no longer a style option

Today's hearing aids come in a range of styles — beginning with small and discreet, all the way to invisible.



Invisible-In-The-Canal Hearing Aids (IIC)

Rest in the second bend of the ear canal, where virtually no one can see them.



Completely-In-Canal Hearing Aids (CIC)

Only the head of a tiny plastic line shows outside the canal.



In-The-Canal Hearing Aids (ITC)

Custom earmold fits in the ear canal. Smaller portion shows in outer ear.



In-The-Ear Hearing Aids (ITE)

Custom earmold that fits within the outer portion of the ear.



Receiver-In-Canal Hearing Aids (RIC)

Small, discreet, and quick to fit. Perfect for many first-time wearers.



Behind-The-Ear Hearing Aids (BTE)

The world's most common style. Available in regular, mini or power.

Did You Know?

- 40 million people in the United States have hearing loss
- 75% of people who could benefit from hearing aids are not using them
- People with hearing loss wait an average of seven years before seeking help
- By age 65, one of out three people have hearing loss
- 10 million Americans have suffered irreversible noise-induced hearing loss, and 30 million more are exposed to dangerous noise levels each day
