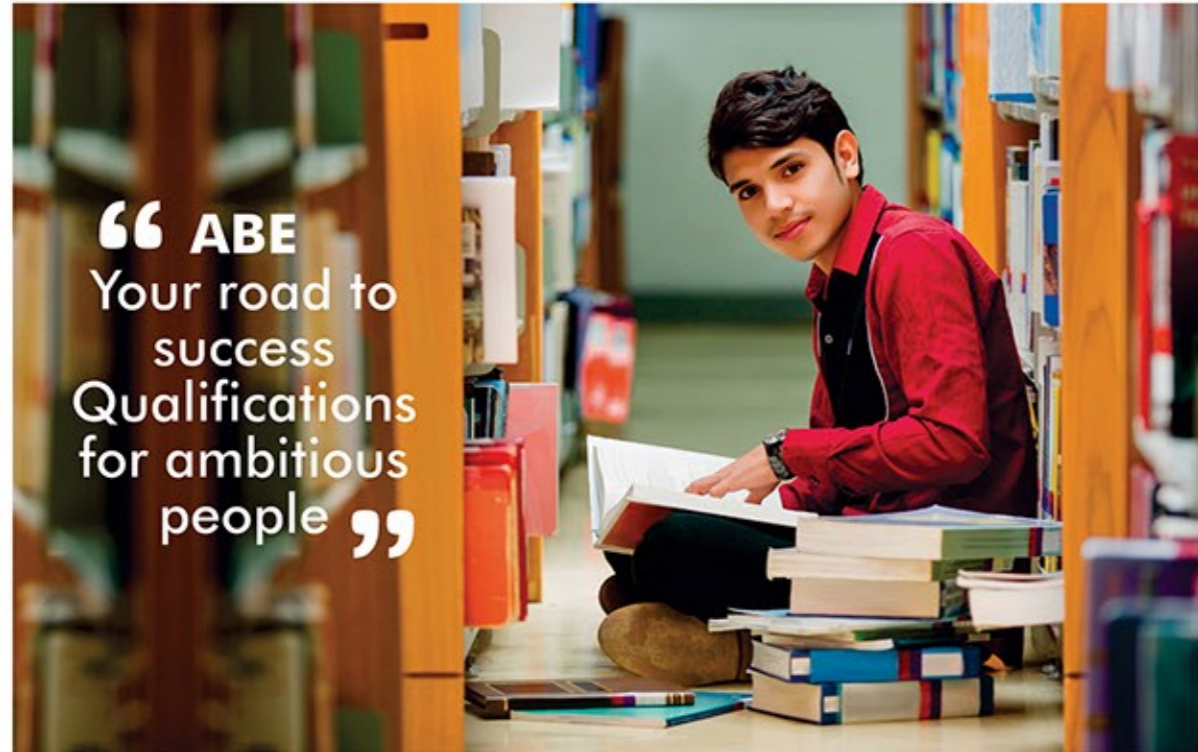

### ECONOMICS MANAGEMENT, FINANCE & SOCIAL SCIENCES (EMFSS)

In the case of Undergraduate courses in Economics, Management, Finance and the Social Sciences (EMFSS), academic direction is provided by the London School of Economics and Political Science (LSE). LSE is a small specialist university with an international intake and a global reach. The certificate that students receive following graduation will state that the student was registered with the University of London and awarded a University of London degree or diploma. It will also state that examinations were conducted by LSE.

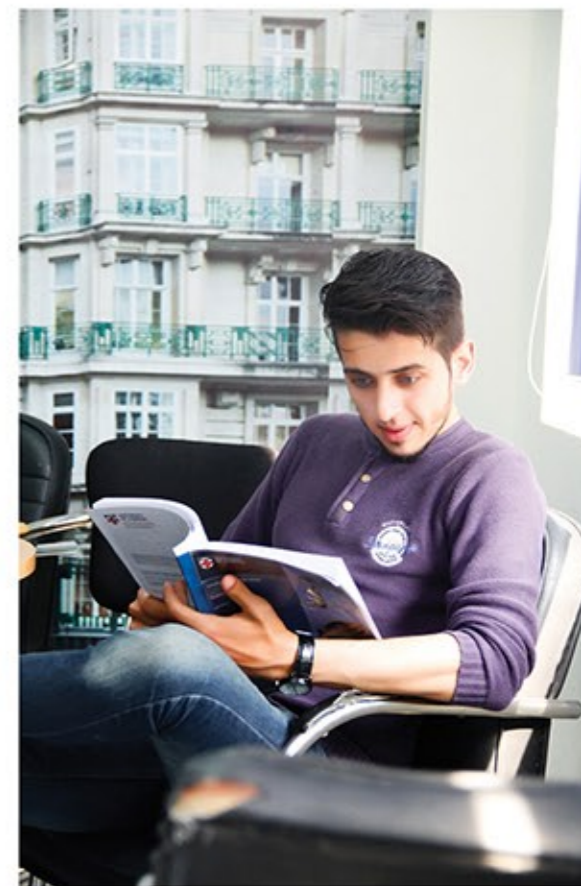

### Eligibility Criteria

Standard Route:

To be eligible for the standard Route you must:

- Normally be at least 17 years old AND
- You must have passes in either: two subjects at GCSE/GCE O-Level at Grade C or above, or three subjects at GCE A-Level (with one A-Level at not less than grade D) or three subjects at GCE A-Level and one further subject at GCSE/GCE O-Level at Grade C or above; or two subjects at GCE A-Level plus two further subjects at GCE AS Level.
- Meet the General Entrance Requirements competence in Mathematics at least equivalent to GCSE/GCE O-level at Grade C or above.
- Provide proof of competence in English which is acceptable to the University. A test of proficiency may be required.





## International Foundation Programme

The International Foundation Programme provides an ideal route to studying one of the UoL degree programmes. University of London International Foundation Programme is a challenging and inspiring new program that has been designed to provide you with skills and knowledge to prepare you for rigorous undergraduate study.

By successfully completing the program you will gain guaranteed entry to ISE-led degrees and develop academic skills that prepare you for undergraduate study.

### Further progression

You will also be able to transfer to diploma in economic and diploma in social sciences, if you wish. IFP also satisfy the entry requirements for the majority of other undergraduate degrees such as LLB and BSC Business Administration.

You can also apply to study for an undergraduate degree offered by other universities, both in UK and else where.

### Study at Metropolitan international University College

MIUC is an approved institution that has been authorised to teach the IFP. Studying at MIUC provides student face to face academic support and the opportunity to interact with fellow student in person.

### Program structure

The IFP consists of four courses (one compulsory and three elective). The program is so flexible that you can complete in minimum of six months and a maximum of three years. MIUC offered its own study schedule and each course require 150 hours of study in institution. This program may not be studied independently

### Entry requirement

To be eligible for IFP you must normally be aged 17 and over before 31 December in the year of registration and have passes in:

A minimum of at least four separate subjects in GCSE/GCE o levels with grade A to C or the equivalent acceptable examination equivalent to GCSE/GCE o level English language at grade C or above or demonstrated fluency in academic English for example a rest of English proficiency such as IELTS at 5.5 overall.



## Certificate of Higher Education in Social Sciences (CHESS)

The Certificate of Higher Education in Social Sciences taught at MIUC is not only a stand-alone qualification, but also a potential entry route to further study in BSc. Students unable to meet the general entry requirements for the Economics, Management, Finance and Social Sciences degrees offered through the International Programmes, with academic direction from LSE, are able to access them after completing this programme successfully. In addition, several universities in the UK, including LSE and other University of London Colleges, will consider you for entry into the second year of a degree. You will need to have passed syllabuses

similar to those taken at the Colleges concerned and to have achieved very high marks.

MIUC allows you to obtain a prestigious qualification at a reasonable cost.

You can study the Certificate of Higher Education in Social Sciences at MIUC to benefit from face-to-face tutorial support and the opportunity to interact with fellow students in person.

### Academic Requirements

- normally be 18 years or older before 31 December in the year you first register with the University
- have passed one GCE/A level at grades A-E and 4 GCSE/O levels at grades A-C OR six GCSE/O levels at grades A-C, or equivalent; and
- have passed GCSE/O level Maths with a grade C or above or equivalent. This qualification will count towards the number of GCSEs/O levels required as stated above; and provide proof

of competence in English which is acceptable to the University. (A test of proficiency may be required)

- Have passed FA, FSc, ICom with 45% above marks
- have been admitted to a full- or part-time course of instruction at an institution which is recognised to teach the Certificate of Higher Education in Social Sciences

- Acceptable examinations equivalent to GCSE/GCE O level English language at grade C or above or demonstrated fluency in academic English (for example, a test of proficiency in
- English such as IELTS at 5.5 overall).

## UOL International Programmes MSc Professional Accountancy

The University of London and the Association of Chartered Certified Accountants (ACCA), the global body for professional accountancy, are enabling you to complete an MSc in Professional Accountancy and your ACCA professional accountancy qualification at the same time. This route to the ACCA qualification will be of value to accountants aspiring to senior roles and enable them to stand out from the crowd in terms of their qualifications. Compared with the cost of studying for an accountancy

qualification and a master's separately, this will save time and money for many ACCA students.

The MSc modules are the first to be recognised by ACCA as counting towards the professional level of the ACCA qualification. You have flexibility regarding how you structure your studies and there are different pathways to the award depending on the level of entrance requirement that you have met. The pathways are outlined below.

#### Prestige

The modules on the new MSc in Professional Accountancy are being developed with academic input from UCL, one of the University of London's constituent Colleges. UCL is ranked seventh

in the world's top universities (QS World University Rankings 2015/16).

#### Programme Benefits

The opportunity to gain a prestigious master's level qualification is open to ACCA students, affiliates and members, no matter what stage they are at in their professional qualification journey.

ACCA members who are qualified and affiliates who have completed all the ACCA assessments can follow a route to 'top-up'

their professional qualification with this master's.

ACCA students who have passed the fundamentals level of the ACCA qualification can opt to continue towards their ACCA qualification by using the master's as an equivalent to two of their final ACCA papers.

#### Programme Details

The three ACCA modules (P1 to P3) you study as part of your ACCA qualification give you accreditation for prior learning (APL) for 90 credits of your master's. The two University of London option modules will be recognised by ACCA as part of your professional qualification.

To qualify to register for the MSc you must be a current ACCA Student and have:

Passed all the ACCA F1 to F9 papers or gained exemptions approved by ACCA, and

Passed the ACCA P1, P2 and P3 papers (or their equivalent).



ACCA - organization provides a framework of qualifications that can lead to Chartered Accountancy. After the skills module of the examinations, students are eligible for obtaining a BSc. (Hons.) in Applied Accounting from the Oxford Brookes University, the UK.

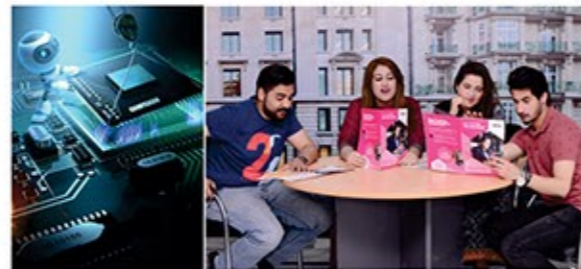
