### WHAT DOES THE FIRE MARSHAL'S OFFICE DO?

#### BUREAU OF INVESTIGATIONS (BOI)

- Assist municipalities with determining the cause of fires and explosions, carbon monoxide releases, and building collapses
- Conducts law enforcement investigations into arson and related crimes
- Fire, carbon monoxide, explosion and building collapse death investigations
- Ignitable liquid detection K-9 unit
- Youth Firesetter education, intervention and reporting

#### BUREAU OF SAFETY & CONSTRUCTION (BSC)

- Building safety and construction as it relates to NH State Fire Code and NH State Building Code
- Fire code enforcement and interpretations
- Fireworks safety & licensing
- Healthcare plan review
- Statewide program administration:
  - Modular building safety
  - School safety inspections
  - State building permits
- Technical plan review

- Assist with Youth Firesetter education
- Community Risk Reduction
