Instruction is multi-faceted with emphasis upon students becoming independent learners who are able to take ownership of their own academic success.

Instruction, including hands-on learning, is provided individually throughout the year through oral practice and written assignments. Immediate feedback. Classroom computers, tablets and iPads are used to provide learning support and interactive learning experience that is positive, engaging and productive.

AREAS OF STUDY

DLC offers a complete and diverse curriculum, covering all subjects students need for academic success, with each area tailored to students' own abilities and requirements.

Reading

Focus is on the development of reading fluency, decoding, comprehension skills, and fostering an enjoyment of reading through exposure to classic literature.

Math

Individual instruction supported by manipulatives and technology. Independent practice is encouraged and acquired concepts are reviewed regularly.

Language Arts

Consists of grammar, spelling, vocabulary and writing, with emphasis on developing both receptive and expressive language skills.

Social Studies and Science

Placement in social studies and science is based on a student's reading comprehension level. We accomplish this by creating books with grade-level content, but on each student's reading level.

Additional Subjects

Discovery Learning Center students also receive instruction in music, library, PE, computer skills, social skills and daily Bible lessons. And, yes, we take field trips!
